CLUB POLICIES

Selecting Teams: A selection committee consisting of coaches as appointed by the president shall select all teams.

Rotation: Players rotate evenly throughout the season except in the cases of injury or illness. During the finals every player shall play at least one quarter of every game.

Training: Training for U/11s through to U/15s is on a Wednesday night from 4.15pm - 5.30pm (5:15pm during the winter months) at Jubilee Park Netball Courts. Training for U/17s will run from 5:30pm - 6:30pm on Wednesday nights. It is compulsory for all players to attend scheduled training. Players who do not attend training nights without notifying their coach may be stood down for the next Saturday game. Seniors may choose to train depending on team and coach availability.

Parents, please note: All YCW players are to be picked up promptly after training and games. Coaches must be notified prior to the start of training if parents cannot get to the courts on time, or if players are unavailable to attend training or games.

Teams: The team playing the highest grade in each age group will also be required to play in some tournaments to be advised by club officials.

End of Season Awards: Any player that displays behaviour contrary to the code of conduct may have their eligibility to receive an award revoked at the digression of the committee. Members will be advised of such behaviour with notification from their coach.

Uniform: The U/11 uniform is a black skirt/skort and black lycra top with club logo. All other teams are to wear the club bodysuit. All players are expected to have a YCW hoodie for game day and they must wear YCW socks (NO BLACK SOCKS). It is imperative that we as a club have uniformity and pride in the club colours.

Weather: If weather conditions are inclement all players must attend training and games unless notified by the coach or via social media on the club Facebook page.

Parent Assistance: A team manager is required per team. Preferably this will be a parent of a player. The team manager are required to score for the team and to assist the coach as the coach as required. All team managers must have a valid working with children check (WWCC) on record. The appointment of each team manager will be made by a committee member.

Fees: Full payment of fees is due in accordance with the fee schedule. Where required, payment plans can be negotiated with the President or Treasurer. **Fees and VNA is NOT refundable.**

Code of Conduct: All players, spectators and club officials must adhere to the code of conduct as signed.
