TOP TIP

DEVELOP YOUR SHOOTING TECHNIQUE

Some Techniques to remember to Shooting

- Elbows & wrists are to point straight, in the direction of the goal post
- Hold the netball above your head
- The shooting hand needs to have the ball resting on the top finger pads (not the fingernails)
- As the hand drops slightly behind the head, bend the knees to power up for the release
- The ball's trajectory should first go up and then drop down into the ring. It should not be thrown flat or on a straight trajectory

Then PRACTICE, PRACTICE, PRACTICE

WHEN AT TRAINING PRACTICE YOUR STANCE, THE POSITION OF YOUR ARMS AND HOW YOU HOLD THE BALL, THESE ARE THE FINER DETAILS..
