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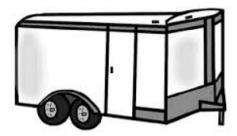
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## WE ARE IN NEED OF A TRAILER!!!!

## **TREASURER**

There are still some fees outstanding, please organise to settle outstanding amounts immediately, unless I have agreed to a payment plan.

Fees are set at the beginning of the year based on the expenditure we expect to incur during the year. We budget to break even during the year and we do not charge a weekly fee.

Some of the weekly costs we incur during the year include court fees (\$25 per team) and umpiring costs (\$7.50 or \$15.00 per team depending on umpire skills). Annual costs include the presentation night food and awards.

The annual VNA part of the fees is paid onto Netball Victoria who set this fee, we do not make any money from this.

At the end of the year we need money to pay for uniforms, if we buy them at seasons end we get a discount which makes them cheaper for people to purchase as required. We also need cash during the year to purchase other uniform items such as Hoodies if we run out of sizes.

Therefore it is important for everyone to pay fees on time, we run on a tight cash flow and I would prefer to keep fees low rather than increase these fees as some parents do not pay fees in a timely manner. Another option for next year would be to increase the fees by say \$20 and offer discounts to people who pay on time.
